

DO I NEED A LAWYER?



Eviction can result in the loss of your home. The state moratorium on evictions is ending, and courts are starting to hear these cases again. Colorado law provides tenants with important legal rights prior to being evicted, with some extra protections for those facing financial hardship due to COVID-19. Talk to a lawyer and find out your rights!

Colorado Legal Services is a statewide nonprofit organization that provides free legal assistance to low-income and elderly tenants in need of housing assistance. If you have been served with an eviction notice, or you are concerned regarding a possible eviction action, then CLS may be able to assist you (subject to certain eligibility criteria and guidelines).

Colorado Legal Services also provides assistance with mobile home ownership, security deposits, uninhabitable conditions and other tenant issues.
